Some Popular Destinations of Uttarakhand

Corbett: Jim Corbett National Park spreads in Nainital, Pauri Garhwal and Bijnor District of Uttarakhand. This forest reserve covers 1318.54 sq kms area in which 520 sq kms is the core area, which is the tiger reserve of Corbett National Park.

Nainital: This hill station situated in the picturesque Kumaon region is situated around the lake Naini. Seven mountains or the Sapta Shring surrounds the city. Apart from its scenic beauty Nainital is famous for its scented candles.

Ranikhet: Ranikhet (The Queen's Field) has come to be known so because according to popular belief, this spot had won the heart of Rani Padmini, Queen of Raja Sudhardev. It is the place which mirrors the best of the Himalayas offering excellent views of the snow capped Nanda Devi.

Badrinath: The Badrinath temple is the main attraction in the town. According to legend Shankara discovered a black stone image of Lord Badrinarayan made of Saligram stone in the Alaknanda River. He originally enshrined it in a cave near the Tapt Kund hot springs.

Kedarnath: Kedarnath Temple is a Hindu temple dedicated to god Shiva. Lord Shiva manifested in the form of Jyotirlingam or the cosmic light. Kedarnath is highest among the 12 Jyotirlingas. It is on the Garhwal Himalayan range near the Mandakini river in Kedarnath.

Kashipur: Kashipur is a major industrial hub in Uttarakhand, acting as a gateway to Nainital, Ranikhet, Corbett National Park, Badrinath, Kedarnath etc. The city also hosts the campus of an IIM (Indian Institute of Management). Major tourist attractions include: Teerth Drona Sagar, Shree Bheem Shankar Moteshwar Mahadev Mandir, Maa Balsundari Mandir, Chaiti Mela, Gurudwara Shri Nankana Sahib, Giri Sarovar etc.

Mussoorie: The queen of the hills, is one of the most popular and fascinating hill resorts of northern India. Its green hills and varied fauna and flora make it a colourful and picturesque hill station.

Haridwar: It is a holy city in the state of Uttarakhand in northern India. Known as the Gateway to the Gods. There is a great statue of Shiva at the fork of the river.

Rishikesh: It is yet another centre of pilgrimage and tourist attraction for Indians as well as foreigners. Rishikesh is popularly known as the Yoga Capital of the World.

Dehradun/Sahastradhara: Sahastradhara, located at a distance of around 14 km from the heart of the city, is a popular tourist attraction of Dehradun. Literally meaning 'Thousands fold Spring', Sahastradhara is a beautiful spring, having a depth of around 9m. Owing to the presence of sulphur in the water of this spring, it is believed to have medicinal value.

Almora: The ancient town of Almora, before its establishment was under the possession of Katyuri king Baichaldeo.

Mukteshwar: At a distance of 52 km. from Nainital, Mukteshwar set atop a high ridge, is a beautiful Himalayan resort. The famous Indian Veterinary Research Institute is also located here.

Bhimtal: The main tourist attraction of this small hill station is its lake. It is one of the largest lakes in the district of Nainital

Hemkund: Hemkunt Sahib is Sikh place of worship, known as Gurudwara Sri Hemkunt Sahib Ji, devoted to Guru Gobind Singh Ji, the tenth Sikh Guru, which finds mention in Dasam Granth, a piece of work believed to be narrated by Guru Gobind Singh Ji.

Kausani: There are very few places in the Himalayas which can compare with the beauty of Kausani. It was originally called Valna. Kausani offers the magic of the deep pine forests and the majestic mountains.

Jageshwar: Counted among the 12 Jyotirlings in the country, Jageshwar lies in a beautiful narrow valley hedged by monarch-sized, ancient deodars.

Binsar: The summer capital of the erstwhile Chand Rajas (7th 18th Century), Binsar is a picturesque, sleepy hamlet one of the most scenic spots in the Kumaon Himalayas.

काशीपुर का गौरवशाली अतीत

काशीपुर एक पौराणिक, धार्मिक, ऐतिहासिक नगरी है। काशीपुर देवभूमि उत्तराखण्ड का एक ऐसा नगर है जिसके महाभारत काल में होने के प्रमाण मिलते हैं। चीनी यात्री ह्वेनसांग ने अपनी यात्रा के वर्णन में यहाँ स्थित तीर्थ द्रोणासागर का उल्लेख तीर्थ स्थल के रूप में किया है। भगवान बुद्ध, गोस्वामी तुलसीदास, स्वामी दयानन्द सरस्वती, महात्मा गाँधी आदि ने अपने समय में तीर्थ द्रोणासागर में कुछ समय व्यतीत कर लोगों को ज्ञान की गंगा के दर्शन कराये थे।

पौराणिक काल में काशीपुर को उज्जैनी के नाम से जाना जाता था। काशीपुर में वर्तमान समय में भी इस नाम का एक मौहल्ला है। काशीपुर के पश्चिम में बहने वाली डेला नदी को प्राचीन समय में स्वर्णभद्रा के नाम से जाना जाता था। तीर्थ द्रोणासागर, खोखराताल व गिरिताल आदि प्रसिद्ध झीलें तथा इस क्षेत्र में स्थित मन्दिर काशीपुर की प्रसिद्धि में चार चाँद लगाते हैं। किवदंतियों के अनुसार प्रसिद्ध द्रोणासागर झील का निर्माण महाभारतकाल में पाण्डवों के गुरु द्रोणाचार्य ने कराया था। पाण्डु पुत्र नकुल ने नीलकण्ठ के नाम से यहाँ शिवमन्दिर की स्थापना की थी। द्रोणासागर क्षेत्र में ही दक्षिणमुखी हनुमान मन्दिर, राधा-कृष्ण मन्दिर तथा पास में गोस्वामी तुलसीदास जी द्वारा रोपा गया वह वृक्ष आज भी लोगों को छाया प्रदान कर रहा है।

काशीपुर के मोटेश्वर मन्दिर में 12 वाँ उपज्योतिर्लिंग स्थापित है जो अपनी मान्यता के कारण सम्पूर्ण भारत में प्रसिद्ध है। माँ बाल-सुन्दरी का मन्दिर चैती मन्दिर के नाम से जाना जाता है तथा इसी में माँ भगवती का शक्तिपीठ भी है जहाँ प्रतिवर्ष चैत्रमाह नवरात्र में भव्य मेले का आयोजन किया जाता है।

चैती मैदान और तीर्थ द्रोणासागर के बीच में स्थित गोविशाण नाम से विशाल टीला जो गुरु द्रोणाचार्य की राजधानी के रूप में जाना जाता था। पुरातत्व विभाग द्वारा वर्ष 1971 कराई गई खुदाई में छठीं शताब्दी का बना मन्दिर तथा उससे निकली त्रिविक्रय की अष्टधातु की भव्य मूर्ति जो इस समय राष्ट्रीय संग्रहालय दिल्ली में सुरक्षित है।

काशीपुर में एक विशाल गुरुद्वारा श्रीननकाना साहिब मोहल्ला पक्काकोट में नागनाथ मन्दिर के निकट स्थित है। यह गुरुद्वारा सिक्खों के लिए इस क्षेत्र का प्रमुख आकर्षण है।

काशीपुर के प्रमुख शिक्षण संस्थान

1. भारतीय प्रबन्धन संस्थान (IIM) काशीपुर:- यह संस्थान प्रबन्धन की गुणवत्त मुक्त शिक्षा प्रदान करने के लिए केलामोड़-कुण्डेश्वरी रोड पर सन 2011 में स्थापित किया गया है। इस संस्थान में देश के ही नहीं बल्कि विदेशी छात्र भी अध्ययन करने के लिए काशीपुर आते हैं।
2. श्रीराम इन्स्टीट्यूट ऑफ मैनेजमेन्ट एण्ड टेक्नोलॉजी (SIMT):- इस संस्थान में स्नातकोत्तर स्तर पर व्यावसायिक प्रबन्धन (एम.बी.ए.), तथा स्नातक स्तर पर व्यावसायिक प्रबन्धन (बी.बी.ए.), व्यावसायिक वाणिज्य (बी.कॉम ऑनर्स), कम्प्यूटर शिक्षा (बी.सी.ए.), शिक्षा-स्नातक (बी.एड.) की शिक्षा की व्यवस्था है। इसका भव्य एवं विशाल भवन सुन्दर लॉन से आच्छादित है। संस्थान काशीपुर रामनगर रोड के 7 कि.मी. पर सन् 2004 से अवस्थित है।
3. राधे हरि राजकीय स्नातकोत्तर महाविद्यालय:- यह महाविद्यालय सन् 1973 ई0 में काशीपुर से बाजपुर रोड पर स्थापित किया गया था। यह महाविद्यालय वाणिज्य, कला और विज्ञान में स्नातकोत्तर तक की शिक्षा प्रदान करता है। यह 33 एकड़ भूमि के विशाल क्षेत्र में स्थापित है। यह तेरह विषयों में पी0 जी0 डिग्री और वाणिज्य, विज्ञान तथा कला वर्ग में पी0एच0डी0 की डिग्री भी प्रदान करता है।
4. उदयराज हिन्दू इण्टर कॉलेज:- भारत के सबसे पुराने इण्टर कॉलेजों में से एक है। यह नागनाथ मानपुर रोड पर स्थित है। इस कॉलेज को राजा उदयराज प्रताप सिंह एवं श्री गोबिन्द बल्लभ पंत द्वारा सन् 1914 मे स्थापित किया गया था।

इतिहास के पन्नों में रामनगर

कुमाऊँ-गढ़वाल की शिवालिक पर्वत श्रृंखलाओं की तलहटी के घनघोर जंगल तथा कोसी नदी के तट पर स्थित रामनगर देवभूमि उत्तराखण्ड का एक प्रमुख नगर है। इतिहास के पन्ने पलटने से यह ज्ञात होता है कि रामनगर क्षेत्र 1800 ई० तक टिहरी के राजा की निजी सम्पत्ति था। गोरखाओं के आक्रमण के समय अंग्रेजों ने टिहरी के राजा की मदद की इसके बदले में 1820 ई० में उसने यह क्षेत्र अंग्रेजों को सौंप दिया। ब्रिटिश सैन्य अधिकारी मेजर रामसे को सन 1888 ई० में पहली बार रामनगर और कार्बेट पार्क में जंगलों की देख-रेख की जिम्मेदारी मिली। सन् 1879 में इस वन क्षेत्र को आरक्षित वन क्षेत्र घोषित किया गया।

जिम कार्बेट नेशनल पार्क:- 8 अगस्त 1936 ई० में यूनाइटेड प्रोविन्स नेशनल पार्क एक्ट के तहत इसे भारत का पहला राष्ट्रीय उद्यान घोषित कर इसको हेली नेशनल पार्क का नाम दिया गया बाद में इसका नाम राम गंगा नेशनल पार्क कर दिया गया। वर्तमान समय में इस पार्क का क्षेत्रफल 1288.32 वर्ग कि.मी. है। सन 1956-57 में मेजर जिम कार्बेट की स्मृति में रामगंगा नेशनल पार्क के नाम को परिवर्तित कर इस पार्क का नाम जिम कार्बेट नेशनल पार्क रखा गया। वर्तमान समय में इस पार्क का नाम कार्बेट टाइगर रिजर्व कर दिया गया है।

गर्जिया देवी मन्दिर:- यह मन्दिर रामनगर का प्रसिद्ध मन्दिर है। यह कोसी नदी के बीच में छोटी पहाड़ी पर स्थित है। वर्तमान समय में इस मन्दिर में गर्जिया माता की 4.5 फुट ऊँची मूर्ति स्थापित है।

श्री हनुमान धाम:- श्री हनुमान धाम रामनगर से 7.5 कि०मी० की दूरी पर छोई के अंजनि गाँव में स्थित है। मंदिर की वास्तुकला दोनों आंतरिक और बाहरी दिखने में शानदार है। इस प्रसिद्ध धाम में दो मछलियों की मूर्तियों से निर्मित एक धनुषाकार प्रवेश द्वार है जो कि भाग्य और समृद्धि को दर्शाता है। यह अलंकृत स्तंभों पर पदानुक्रमित तरीके से एक भव्य छत्री प्रकार की उपस्थिति देता है।

कोसी बैराज बाँध:- रामनगर में उत्तराखण्ड का प्रसिद्ध कोसी बैराज बाँध स्थित है। इस बाँध की ऊँचाई समुद्र तल से 1132 फुट है। यह हिमालय की तलहटी में कोसी नदी पर बना है।

रामनगर से सटी सुन्दर पहाड़ियाँ:- रामनगर के पास हिमालय पर्वत की शिवालिक पहाड़ियों पर घनघोर हरे-भरे वृक्ष, जंगली जानवरों की आवाज, चिड़ियों की चहचाहट, कोसी नदी की कल-कल करती हुई पानी की ध्वनि, नाना प्रकार के वृक्षों की निराली छटा मन को मोह लेती है।

रामनगर के प्रसिद्ध शिक्षण संस्थान:- पी०एन०जी०पी०जी० महाविद्यालय रामनगर का एक मात्र स्नातकोत्तर महाविद्यालय है जहाँ विज्ञान, कला व वाणिज्य वर्ग तीनों की शिक्षा प्रदान की जाती है। इस महाविद्यालय के अतिरिक्त राजकीय, जी०पी०पी०, एम०पी०आई०सी० इण्टर कॉलेज आदि हैं।

प्रसिद्ध पुस्तकालय:- रामनगर शहर में आर्य समाज का प्रसिद्ध प्राचीन स्वामी दयानन्द सरस्वती पुस्तकालय तथा नगर पालिका का पुस्तकालय जो लोगों के लिए ज्ञान की गंगा बहाते हैं।

रिसोर्ट:- रामनगर में 200 से भी अधिक बहुत से सुन्दर रिसोर्ट हैं जहाँ पर ठहरने की उत्तम व्यवस्था है। वैल्कम हैरिटेज, कार्बेट गेटवे स्पा रिजार्ट, कार्बेट काउंटी रिजार्ट, कार्बेट सुमन ग्रेड, इन्फिनिटी रिजार्ट, कार्बेट जंगल आदि प्रमुख रिजार्ट हैं।

काशीपुर के आसपास

बाजपुर:- बाजपुर ऊधम सिंह नगर का एक मुख्य व्यावसायिक/औद्योगिक नगर है। बाजपुर की स्थापना सत्रहवीं शताब्दी में चंदवर्षीय राजा लक्ष्मीचंद (1597-1621) द्वारा की गई और बाद में राजा बाज बहादुर के नाम पर इसका नाम पड़ा। भारत वर्ष की प्रथम सहकारी चीनी मील का श्रेय भी बाजपुर को है, जिसका उद्घाटन भारत के प्रथम प्रधानमंत्री पंडित जवाहर लाल नेहरू ने किया था। बाजपुर उद्योग के अतिरिक्त अपनी कृषि की पैदावार के लिए भी विख्यात है। यहाँ पर पेप्सी, पालीप्लैक्स, शुगर फैक्ट्री, डिस्टीलरी, रेल फासनर जैसे बड़े उद्योग भी स्थापित हैं।

जसपुर:- जसपुर एक गाँव से बड़े शहर के रूप में विकसित किया गया है। यह विशेष तौर पर अपनी गंगा जमुनी संस्कृति के लिए जाना जाता है। जसपुर में परम्परागत लकड़ी मंडी और कपड़ा आधारित उद्योग हैं। इस स्थान की प्रसिद्ध और स्वादिष्ट पकवान पानी अखरोट द्वारा बनी कचरी है। जसपुर के निकट नादेही शुगर मिल व कई पेपर मिल हैं। उद्योगों के अतिरिक्त कई शिक्षण संस्थान भी विशेषमहत्व रखते हैं, जिनमें बी०एस०वी० डिग्री कॉलेज, मानक बुद्धिस्त इंटरनेशनल इंस्टीट्यूट व पूर्णानन्द तिवारी इन्टर कॉलेज मुख्य रूप से उल्लेखनीय हैं।

Preparation tips for interview round

- 1) Read your resume completely.
- 2) Prepare question which can be asked by the interview panel. Questions related to your academic records and your hobbies are generally asked by the interview panel.
- 3) Read about the organisation for which you are interviewed, go through the official website of the organisation once completely and have a look on the products and services offered by the company.
- 4) Rehearse your interview round, give interview in front of your teacher or an interview expert few times before the actual interview.
- 5) Prepare for presentation if they ask.



Consider the following points

Be punctual - Arrive on time better; half an hour earlier. Have a positive body language, good eye contact, wear neat and clean clothes. During the interview be confident about your answers and be true and loyal to interview panel. Don't hide your weaknesses and accept your weak areas in front of interview panel. Good communication skills are essential for success in any interview, so work on your communication skills also. Interview panel may ask the candidate to write something or to draw anything, so well prepare with your stationary items as well.

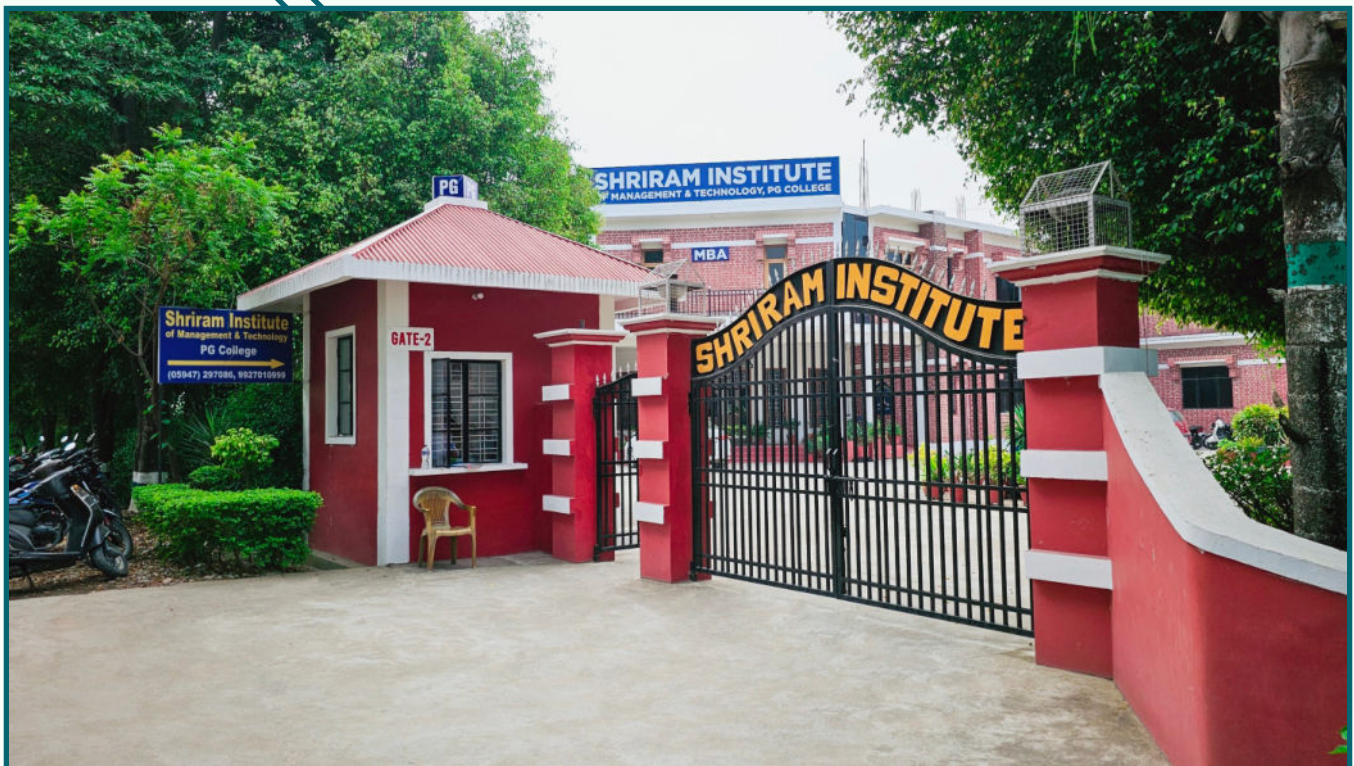

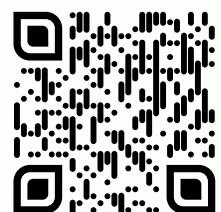
